



Statement of Memory Volatility for DMC-VID-BNC

The DMC-VID-BNC is an input card for a Crestron DigitalMedia™ Switcher, providing one analog video input and one balanced stereo analog audio input. It uses the following memory types: EEPROM, SRAM and FLASH PROM. The memory used in this unit holds only firmware, operational parameters and user presets. No user audio/video data is retained in memory upon power down.
