Installation

Install the Acoustic Back Can

Mount the <u>SPKA-BC-IC6/IC8</u> coustic back can accessory over the Reference and Ultimate speakers. This accessory must be purchased separately.

- 1. Install the Reference and Ultimate speakers as per the Quick Start Docs: 8968, 8970, and 9036.
- 2. Connect the wire leads within the acoustic back can to the inputs on the speaker.


NOTE: Make sure that the back can is secured properly over the speaker – the screw holes of the acoustic back can should sit evenly on the corresponding surface of the speaker housing without any gaps and without having to apply force.

- 3. Place the acoustic back can on the top of the speaker.
- 4. Insert the six supplied screws into the holes of the acoustic back can.
- 5. Tighten the screws until the acoustic back can is secure. Do not overtighten.
- 6. Connect the speaker wire from the amplifier to the terminals on the acoustic back can.

NOTE: Make sure that the positive cable is attached to the red connection, and the negative cable is attached to the black connection.
