

# Installation/Configuration Procedures

These procedures assume that the SW-WMC Windows Media Center Interface Software program has been downloaded from the Crestron website to the Windows Media Center. To use the program, it must first be installed and configured.

### Installation

Locate the downloaded program and do the following:

• Double-click the SW-WMC\_Setup.exe icon to open the SW-WMC InstallShield Wizard.



- Click **Next**, and when the "License Agreement" screen appears (not shown here), click the "accept" statement, and click **Next** again.
- When the SW-WMC Setup Wizard welcome screen appears, click **Next** to begin the setup process.



• Click **Next** to go to the "Confirm Installation" screen.

• Follow the instructions to identify the folder where the SW-WMC program is to be installed.
