

- 2. Drill holes at the marked screw hole locations and install the two included anchors and two 3.5 x 33 mm Phillips pan head mounting screws.






Removing the Desktop Mounting Plate from the Phone

1. Remove the rubber caps from the wall mount slots.






- 2. Slide the mounting bracket into the wall mount slots.
- 3. Secure the mounting bracket to the phone using the included 3×6 mm Phillips flat head screws.


